### **The IHRC Corporation and the IHRC Alliance member organizations have headquarters, representative offices and offices in:**

Autonomous Republic of Abkhazia (Georgia), Czech Republic, Democratic Republic of Congo, Pakistan, Slovak Republic, Swiss Confederation, Republic of Chad, Republic of Guinea-Bissau, Republic of Lebanon, Republic of Niger, Republic of Nigeria and Ukraine.

### **IHRC Foreign Team**

The IHRC Foreign Team is mainly composed of local human rights and humanitarian activists who are actively involved in our organization and build our structures on the ground. They establish contacts with state and local authorities and are key players in carrying out activities and supporting the local community. Many of these leaders also serve in the IHRC diplomatic corps.

### **Diplomatic Corps**

The IHRC Diplomatic Corps currently consists of around 100 people from 38 countries. They cooperate on a daily basis with governments, institutions and authorities of countries with which the IHRC has already concluded agreements or with which such agreements are imminent. In addition, the Corps negotiates with the authorities of many countries on joint measures to protect human rights. It also supports local IHRC offices in cooperation with local and state authorities and in the planning, coordination and logistics of humanitarian aid. An important role of the IHRC Diplomatic Corps is to support and provide technical support to the SMM-IHRC volunteers working on site. Through diplomatic recognition by state authorities, the IHRC facilitates the implementation of its own projects and cooperation with organizations aligned with its platforms without encountering bureaucratic obstacles or risks, thus reducing administrative costs.

### **IHRC Peacemaker Force**

Within the IHRC Corporation, the IHRC Peacemaker Force units were established. These are globally distributed, highly organized formations consisting of the Central Command, Regional Commands, Operational Units and Specialized Sub-Units. This structure enables effective performance of peacekeeping, humanitarian and mediation missions around the world. It serves as a special intergovernmental mediation unit established for rapid response in conflict zones and prevention of humanitarian crises. Its main tasks include: 1. Mediation and peace negotiations in conflict-affected regions; 2. Monitoring compliance with human rights and international law; 3. Ensuring the protection of civilians in crisis situations. 4. Cooperation with governments, international organizations and UN peacekeeping forces. 5. Supporting the reconstruction of state structures and democratic institutions.

## **IHRC Alliance activities**

## **International Cooperation**

Global collaboration platforms are the preferred form of IHRC activities. Their application defines the principles of cooperation, including transparency, partnership and equality of participants, sincerity of intentions and actions, and the pursuit of jointly agreed goals. This does not mean that disagreements cannot arise, but creates space for synergy, the discovery of new approaches and a sense of mutual support. This is one of the main reasons for the rapid and significant increase in the importance and perception of IHRC by international communities and authorities as an initiator and efficient implementer of projects with local and global reach.

## **European Union RAN cooperation**

At the same time, our representatives from all over the world, as part of the IHRC delegation, actively participate in the work of many commissions and task forces of the European Commission and share their experiences. By participating in these works, they learn about new issues and methods and can then implement them in the relevant state and social structures in their country.
